Riverside Health Care in conjunction with the Northwestern Public Health Unit has declared a Respiratory Outbreak at Rainy River Health Centre.

As a precautionary measure all symptomatic individuals have been tested for COVID-19, currently all tests are negative. We remind the public that this is not a COVID-19 outbreak at this time.

All admissions, transfers, discharges and group social activities are cancelled until further notice.

Visitor restrictions have been added to permit ONLY 1 Visitor/caregiver per Resident at a time. Visitation must take place in the Resident's room and not in common space areas during the Outbreak. Palliative visitors are still permitted. Any Resident absences for social purposes are not permitted at this time.

To further enhance our team's ongoing efforts additional precautions are being taken including, but not limited to, isolation of symptomatic individuals, additional high touch cleaning practices, and cohorting residents and staff where possible. We believe these added measures will enhance the facility's ability to reduce the risk of transmission.

The Outbreak Management Team will continue to monitor the situation. The care and safety of our residents, team members and families are a top priority.
